

Who We Are


The Solano County Chapter of the Links, Incorporated has a long tradition of promoting and engaging in educational, civic and inter-cultural activities that enrich the lives of members of the Black community at large. The cornerstone of our service is our five programming facets — Services to Youth, The Arts, National Trends and Services, International Trends and Services, and Health and Human Services. Through our facets, we implement programs and initiatives that address the most critical needs of underserved communities. Annually, we impact the lives of more than 3 million people at home and abroad.

In 2024, the Solano County Chapter of The Links, Incorporated (SCCL) **celebrated 30 years of service** as a part of our Annual Scholarship Fundraiser. During this time, SCCL has provided over \$185,000 in college scholarships to graduating seniors from Fairfield, Suisun, Travis, Vallejo, and Vacaville communities. The women that make up this chapter are linked together in friendship and service. Over the last year, the national membership of the Links has collectively contributed over 1 million hours of volunteer work.

Event Details

Our Annual Scholarship Fundraiser is an annual luncheon that awards and honors graduating seniors and their academic achievements with monetary awards. The event is an opportunity to fundraise, publicly salute, and celebrate students who have worked hard and some who have overcome tremendous odds to not only graduate high school but gain admission to an accredited four-year institution.

Scholarship winners are also presented with Certificates of Recognition from Solano County Board of Supervisors and California State Assembly Office. A number of public officials, school administrators, counselors and teachers routinely attend this signature event which also features entertainment, vendors, raffles and other prizes.

The Links, Incorporated created its first program facet, Services to Youth, to empower black youth to use their intellect and spirit of achievement to become successful and productive citizens. Through this facet, we implement transformational programs that are responsive to the academic, cultural, career development, and mentoring needs of youth.

The Links, Incorporated creates and supports art-related educational opportunities for minority youth as well as presents and supports performances by youth and accomplished professional artists in an array of disciplines. In partnership with museums, symphonies and other culturally based disciplines.

National Trends and Services




